- Certify that all information provided in their application form and in all accompanying documents is true, accurate and complete

- A 250-word essay, stating your reason for choosing a healthcare profession, how you anticipate that this
 education opportunity will support your career path, and if you intend to return to and work in the Bow
 Valley after graduation.
- A breakdown/itemized list of anticipated expenses
- A letter of recommendation / support from a member of the community
- Resume or CV
- Confirmation of registration

Incomplete or late applications will not be considered. The deadline for all applications is 4:00 pm on June 30, 2024.

These awards can be used for course/registration fees, travel to and from school, living expenses while attending an educational program in health care, and required course materials such as books and supplies.
