

# Help Upgrade our Hospital Facility



The current Canmore Hospital building was constructed in 1984. It includes a 24-hour emergency department, cancer clinic, two surgical suites, along with 25 acute and 23 long-term care beds. The hospital employs approximately 350 staff with 90+ physicians having patient care privileges.

Canmore Hospital Foundation plays a vital role in ensuring upgrades to the hospital facility are made. Each year approximately **\$1.0 million dollars is required to** address the small renovation projects and anticipate large capital upgrades identified as essential by hospital staff. These projects result in our hospital being able to accommodate new equipment and staff being able to deliver the latest treatments to their patients.

## Maintenance is Ongoing and Renovation is Vital Thank you for your

ongoing support

Large capital upgrades funded by Canmore Hospital Foundation since 2010:

- The renovation of the Bow Valley Cancer Care Clinic was completed in 2010 with fundraised dollars matched by Guy Turcotte
- Two new labour and delivery rooms were added in 2017 and made possible by a gift from the Heuckroth family
- The \$1.5 million dollar enhancement of the Golden Eagle View Long Term Care Facility was achieved through donations from the community, local events, & major donor contributions.
- The \$4.4 million dollar revitalization of the Emergency Department was funded by a \$2.2 million dollar investment from AHS matched by Foundation donors.

Recent facilities enhancements supported by Canmore Hospital Foundation and our partners:

- A rebuilt fence and deck for Long Term Care residents funded by BOWDA
- Two new staffrooms for nurses and care providers in Golden Eagle View funded by the Doyon Family
- A new endoscopy suite funded by Origin at Spring Creek and The Canmore Hospital Ladies Auxiliary
