WHY DO WE RAISE FUNDS FOR THESE ORGANIZATIONS?



Canmore & Area Health Care Foundation was created by regional health authority to raise funds to maintain and enhance health care for the people of the communities served by the regional health authority in Canmore area and, in particular, to finance or assist in the financing of the construction, equipping, and support of those healthcare facilities, programs and services forming part of the regional health authority.

The Canmore & Area Health Care Foundation raises money to improve health care in the Bow Valley, including Canmore, Harvie Heights, Exshaw, Kananaskis, Lac Des Arcs, and the Municipal District of Bighorn. The Foundation focuses on purchasing equipment and enhancing premises that would not be purchased or enhanced through regular government funding.

Previous Murrieta's Golf Tournaments have helped to purchase equipment for Cardiac Care and to expand the Cancer Clinic in the Canmore Hospital.

This year, the funds from the Murrieta's Golf Tournament will help to purchase lifesaving medical equipment for use at Canmore General Hospital. On an annual basis Canmore and Area Health Care Foundation responds to dozens of requests from across hospital departments that each require updated tools, devices, technologies, etc. Access to the latest medical equipment ensures that physicians and medical staff can provide the best care possible for their patients. Through the generosity and continued support of community partners like Murrieta's the Foundation has been able to provide approve more than \$600,000.00 in equipment purchase requests over the last two years. This year with the renovation of the Emergency Department the Foundation anticipates even more requests for state-of-the-art equipment that will ensure Canmore General Hospital remains an attractive, modern and vital medical facility.

ABOUT SAFE HAVEN FOUNDATION



ESTABLISHED IN 1996

The Safe Haven Foundation of Canada was born from one couple's personal mission to develop a program dedicated to keeping homeless, and at-risk teenage girls safe, off the streets, and in school. An extensive study confirmed the need for a comprehensive program that provided a long-term home and all the necessary supports for girls who would otherwise be calling the streets 'home.'

In November of 2000, The Safe Haven Foundation opened its door to young women between the ages of 14 and 24. Our founding program, Haven's WayTM, has been widely recognized as the first of its kind in Canada. While the concept is simple – to duplicate that of a healthy caring family environment, the execution is as complicated and challenging as any parent can imagine. Successes came quickly, but not without challenges. While the philosophies and beliefs on which the program was founded have been put to the test, to this day they remain intact and as strong as the day we started.

At Safe Haven Foundation we build families out of strangers, providing homeless and at-risk girls a safe and loving home. A live-in house parent, peer mentor and a dedicated programming team ensure the young women we serve are surrounded with all the necessary supports so they can work through their traumas and overcome their barriers, complete their education and become self-reliant contributing citizens in our community. Continued support and community engagement extend far beyond the girls' time in the Haven's WayTM Homes providing the support network, the familial sense of belonging and the unconditional love every child deserves.
